Born prematurely, Jude suffered from respiratory failure shortly after birth. He was sent to the MU Health Care NICU in Columbia from their hospital in Jefferson City.

"This was our first kid, and he stopped breathing in my arms," said his mother, Cailin. "I couldn't imagine being 30 minutes away from him."

Cailin and Aaron stayed at the mid-Missouri Ronald McDonald House for two weeks in 2022. The amenities at the House brought a sense of comfort to the family.

**"We had an easy pregnancy, an easy, quick delivery," said Cailin. "There was no reason to think there was going to be anything other than us staying at the hospital a couple of days and getting to go home. So, we were not prepared at all, and every day, we didn't know how long we would be staying."**

In June 2024, Jude was diagnosed with a rare blood sugar condition and now wears a continuous glucose monitor. The family returned to Columbia last summer, staying for a week at Jude's bedside and was grateful for the Ronald McDonald Family Room®.

"It was incredibly helpful to be able to do laundry because we just didn't know how long we were going to have to stay," said Cailin.

During separate medical journeys, Cailin and Aaron utilized the resources at the Ronald McDonald House and Ronald McDonald Family Room. In honor of Jude's birthday this year, the Miller family donated a collection of toys and toiletries to the Ronald McDonald House.

# Growing Our Mission Programs: Lunch on the House



Our Lunch on the House program has grown tremendously this past year!

We increased our free lunch deliveries from twice per week to three times per week at the beginning of 2025, and as of July 1, we are now delivering healthy sack lunches four times per week!

The volume of lunches isn't the only thing growing within the program. We've added new options to our lunch menu: chicken bacon ranch wraps, veggie wraps, chicken Caesar wraps, and chicken salad croissants.

These upgrades to our Lunch on the House program mean that families receive more lunches and more options!

Parents staying at their child's bedside need one less thing to worry about. We prepare and deliver bagged lunches to families at MU Health Care Children's Hospital, Boone Hospital, and the Thompson Center for Autism

and Neurodevelopment every Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday.

The staff and families at RMHC Mid-MO are incredibly thankful for the ongoing altruism of our Lunch on the House volunteers. From our groups who pack the lunches to the drivers who deliver them, each person plays an essential role in fulfilling our mission of serving more families, better.

# New Vegetable Garden Beds at the Ronald McDonald House

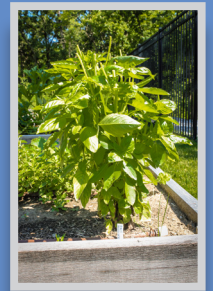
In the beginning...

# A Place to Continue Forward, A Chance to Give Back

When Denver was born eight weeks prematurely, parents Brett and Abigail needed to stay close to their son during his time in the NICU. After learning about Ronald McDonald House Charities® of Mid-Missouri, the Ulhorns took advantage of the resources offered to them at the Ronald McDonald House®.

"No one can afford to drive an hour back and forth or stay in a hotel every day for seven weeks," said Abigail. "It allowed me to be with Denver every single day. It was so awesome."

During their 34-night stay, the family was grateful for the nightly, home-cooked meals that they were able to return to after a day at the hospital.



"You're already away from home, so you don't want to eat out every day," said Abigail. "So, having a hot meal that isn't fast food was so beneficial to our family."

The amenities in both the Ronald McDonald House and the Ronald McDonald Family Room® both surprised and impressed the Ulhorn family.

"We weren't expecting to have snacks, or leftover food, or a place to just hang out, said Abigail. "Whenever you think of something like this, you think of a little, one-bedroom place. But it was so nice, and it was just honestly a home away from home."

As a way to give back, Graceful Goods Bakery, owned by Abigail, hosted a fundraiser in April that raised almost \$2,000. The proceeds went to Wish List Wednesday items, a general donation to RMHC Mid-Missouri, and a donation to the MU Health Care NICU babies.

"In school, you learn about the Ronald McDonald [House], and they show you a video, and you're like, 'Oh yeah, that's kind of cool,' and then you just forget about it," said Abigail. "But now that we've experienced it, we're like, 'Wow, this is such a great thing! We want to keep giving and giving whenever we can because it was so beneficial for us. So, we want it to be there for future families.'"

**Denver is happy and thriving. Thanks to your ongoing support, Brett and Abigail spent the first month of their son's life right by his side as his health improved.**
